Dear Parents,

Today is the end of the first quarter; report cards will be available on-line via OptionC on October 20 and Parent/Teacher Conferences are on October 21st and 22nd. Conferences are virtual via zoom or telephone. Your child's/children's homeroom teacher will contact you to set up conference time.

With the approval for the USDA Summer Meals Waivers program, all school lunches from September 1 thru December 31 will be paid for through the USDA Summer Meals program. Your Option C account will still be charged for meals; however the charges will be credited as we receive payment from the USDA. All children from age 2-18 are eligible to receive lunch at no cost. If you have other children at home, not receiving a lunch elsewhere (day care center, other school) you may order a lunch and pick it up in the school office. Lunches must be ordered by 9:00 by calling the cafeteria at 566-2880, and may be picked up at the school office at 11:40.

Beginning on Tuesday, October 13 Mascoutah School District will provide bus transportation for our students who live in areas serviced by the MSD buses. (There will be days when the service is not available and will be noted in the News and Notes – i.e. early dismissal days, Election Day etc.) Each bus will carry up to 44 children and they will be seated 2 per seat. Their plan is to seat students starting with the back seats first to the front of the bus and then unload front to back. All students whose parents have contacted me about the bus service are on the MSD list. If you are planning to use the MSD buses and have not contacted me, please contact me as soon as possible.
