Principal's Report – Mr. Keefe:

- a. School Summer Cleaning: Mr. Kerwin doing a great job deep cleaning the school. The cafeteria floor has been replaced and looks amazing. The teacher's lounge got a facelift as well and looks great.
- b. Enrollment: Enrollment is going well. There is currently 157 registered (K-8). Continuing to monitor Pre-K numbers.
- c. Faith Formation Mass this year is Tuesday and Thursday for K-8. There is a new curriculum for religion classes. Mrs. Beck and Mrs. Cozzi will be presenting a program "Catholic Brain" to staff on Aug 15th.
- d. Extracurricular Athletic Co-op with St. Libory will not be occurring. The proposal was disapproved by St Libory board. HCS fall soccer may have limited use of Mascoutah High School filed due to competing programs. Ms. Kilian is exploring other local options for practice and home games. There will be a coaches meeting

August 1st. Parents have been contacted to ensure all athletes have current sports physical (within 390 days) on file. Ms. Uptergrove asked about the status of capping Wed night athletics at 6pm like the High School. It had been discussed with the athletic program before Fr Nick left. Mr. Keefe/Fr Mark will inquire.

- e. Math Curriculum 5, 6, and 7 will be together 8th grade will have the choice for kids to be in pre-algebra or algebra. Exploring possibilities to have paid math tutoring available (more to come).

 - 2. After Care: Peyton Yarber hired for After-Care program. Looking for one additional staff member.
 - 3. Custodial: Mr. Todd's last day is Fri. Mr. Kerwin is projected to retire later this year and plans are being made to advertise the position in Sep.
